

Plastic Remembrance Poppies

We learnt why we celebrate Remembrance Day in Reception. We learnt all about the soldiers and why we wear a poppy. We then made plastic poppies.

- Bottom of plastic bottles
- Red acrylic paint
- Black circles of paper



1. Firstly, use the scissors to carefully cut the bottom off a plastic bottle. I suggest cutting just above any dimples on the base of the bottle.
2. Once your bottle bottoms are detached, use scissors to cut four slits so you can open up the bottle.
3. Paint the inside of the bottle bottoms with two (or more) coats of red acrylic paint.
4. Once the red paint is dry turn the poppy over and that side is shiny. Then stick a black circle into the centre of the poppy.
