

## **MASTERY LEARNING: DEVELOPING GREAT ORATORS**

There are 4 aspects to purposeful talk:

PHYSICAL: Use voice and body language

LINGUISTIC: Vocabulary and voice register COGNITIVE: Content, and audienc

**SOCIAL / EMOTIONAL:** Confidence to speak, listen and respond others

Strategies to promote oracy in the classroom (Exploratory talk: where students can develop, build and challenge their learning through talk)

Embed clear ground rules for talk so that it is purposeful and students can reflect on the quality of their talk.



TALKING **POINTS** 

Pose a controversial or open question to spark discussion between students.

- always sometimes never
- would you rather
- odd one out

Use sentence stems to deepen the quality of dialogue.

- scaffolded sentence stems
- use of display



**EXPLORATORY** QUESTIONS

Improve the quality of talk by asking better questions. Ask questions with clear purpose. Use the initiate-response-feedback model to elevate classroom talk.

- auestion matrix
- think pair share
- full sentences
